

Easter Sunday: The Moment that Changed Everything

How to Use Talk It Over:

This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Christ Church Otsego. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

Pastor Greg's Main Idea:

Easter changed the world forever. Those who have received Jesus as their Savior are called to “live their dash” for him.

Scripture Passage: Matthew 28:1-10, 1 John 5:11-12

What is most interesting or remarkable to you about the Easter Gospel story?

Why do you think that Jesus emphasized the fact that the disciples would see him?

Describe your understanding of the phrase in 1 John, “Whoever has the Son has life...”

Discussion Questions:

Our new series title is “Living the Dash.” What does the dash represent?

What is the difference between just “believing” in Jesus and actually “receiving” him as your Savior and Lord?

If life can be compared to a 100 meter dash, which part of the race are you in? Where is your focus these days?

Pastor Greg said, “The most significant marking on your tombstone will not be the date of your birth or the date of your death. It will be the dash in-between. The dash represents the unique and precious life that God has given you to live.” What would you like people to say about your dash some day?
