- Experience Leader You and your team will staff the stations and activities that will have the guests laughing, playing ,creating, and hearing about Jesus. You will recruit volunteers to serve as shopkeepers and provide them with their scripts and instructions.
- Registration Team Leader You'll welcome and register guests at The City Gates. Collect guests' contact information so we can follow up with them. Direct them where they need to go to begin the experience.
- Follow-up Team Leader You'll compile the contact and participation information about guests who attended and implement the follow-up strategy to invite first-time guests to return to our church by sending out a mailer with the photo that was taken during the event.
