About Us

At Christ Church Preschool, we prepare children for Kindergarten. We do this by educating, developing, and encouraging them to grow academically, socially, and spiritually. Our dedication to quality education is proven by our Parent Aware rating. By the time your child completes preschool, they will have the skills they need to be successful in elementary school.

Your three/four-year old will learn:

- To spend time away from parents in a classroom setting
- To develop socially by learning to share, follow instructions, resolve conflict and make decisions while interacting with friends and teachers
- To independently put on outdoor clothes, pour their drink during snack, and use a public restroom
- Introduction to basic letter and number recognition, EZ Write stroke development, colors, and shapes
- Large motor skills through outdoor play on our playground
- How to try new foods such as fruits, vegetables, grains, dairy, and more
- That Jesus loves them through Bible stories, prayers and songs

In addition to the skills listed above, your four/five-year old will learn:

- EZ Write stroke development (used by ISD 728) and how to write their name
- Letter sounds and phonics
- Numbers, letters, colors, and shapes in English and Spanish
- To experience three field trips and riding on a school bus

A Typical Day

Learning Centers Time: Children start their day by learning through play and exploration in our Learning Centers. During this time children work on:

- social and emotional development
- approaches to learning
- creativity and the arts
- cognitive development
- language and literacy
- physical and motor development | Teachers observe the children during

their interactions to assess developmental readiness.

Group Time: The Teacher gathers the children together for a Bible story, children's stories, songs, poems, music, calendar, weather, EZ writing, and art.

Snack Time: Children wash their hands and are offered a healthy snack from two different food groups. They are encouraged to try new foods, pour their own beverages, use table manners, and clean up after themselves.

Large Motor Time: Children complete their day using large motor skills outside in the playground. Indoor activities are provided when the weather does not allow for outdoor play.

Your child will be taught under the caring guidance of a Teacher and an Assistant Teacher/Aide. Our class ratios are not higher than one staff member per ten children. Our staff attend continuing education courses throughout the year in order to ensure that they are following the most current best practices for Early Childhood Education.

We introduce concepts of faith through prayer, Bible stories, holiday celebrations, and our actions. Our staff prays with the children before snack.
