How to Use Talk It Over: This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Christ Church Otsego. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

How do we know that God actually hears our prayers and responds to our individual needs? And those of our church?

What are some of the factors that pull our eyes down towards the things of earth and keep us from looking up to God?

How can you encourage others personally with Psalm 121:1-2?

How can you contribute personally to helping Christ Church move forward with our vision of discipleship and outreach?
