SAN AUGUSTINE COUNTY

The City of San Augustine is located in the heart of Texas Forest Country in Deep East Texas. It is a town of about 2000 people and it is the county seat. But it also struggles because of its rural location and declining economy.

In the city of San Augustine 31% of the people live below the poverty line. That is nearly 1 out of every 3 people. 60% of children from birth through 11 years old live in poverty.

We will be doing major home repair projects which will make a <u>dramatic</u> difference in the lives of the people living there.

The dates: June 22-July 2, 2022

Cost: \$625 for students \$595 for adults

This cost includes 3 days of camping, all transportation, food while camping and at our mission site, and lodging. You will need to bring additional money for food while we are traveling and souvenirs if you desire.

A NON-refundable deposit of \$100 is due by Sunday, December 26.

Mission Trip Student/Adult Minister Covenant

In participating in this mission trip I understand that I am a Student or Adult Minister and I will be representing Jesus Christ. I understand that this comes with high expectations of moral character and behavior. The following is a list of some of the standards that I will be accountable for with the understanding that it is not an exhaustive list.

As a Student or Adult Minister, I will:

- Lead by example. I will follow all of the rules.
- Keep a positive attitude at all times, realizing that my attitude will often determine the attitude of others.
- I understand this is a ministry. I will be Jesus' representative at all times.
- Not enter into an area that is designated for the opposite sex.
- Make God honoring choices in words and actions at all times.
- Focus on the people I am there to help. This involves building a relationship with them and serving joyfully and generously.
- Be an ambassador for Christ and represent Christ Church to the best of my ability.
- Stay with the group at all times. I will not go anywhere alone.
- Willingly and cheerfully participate in all activities.
- Dress modestly and wear clothing that honors God and the people we are serving. For example, as this pertains to swimwear, for this trip bikinis will not be allowed. One-piece swimsuits are required for girls. Guys will be required to wear shirts when working at the mission site and sleeping in public places.
- Abstain from the use of alcohol and tobacco while on this trip.
- Work as though working for the Lord, not for men. (Col. 3:23) I will look for ways to help and be a productive team member from start to finish.
- Commit to be at all of the mission trip meetings, unless excused in advance by Pastor Sean or Teri. I understand that missing more than one meeting may jeopardize my ability to go on this trip. <u>NOTE</u>: If you have a concern or questions about this, please talk to Teri or Pastor Sean before you register.
- Students must be actively involved in our High School ministry, including a Wednesday night Grounded group. An exception may be made for a student who does not attend Christ Church and is actively and regularly involved in their church's youth group on Wednesday nights.
