- Dress modestly and wear clothing that honors God and the people we are serving. For example, as this pertains to swimwear, for this trip bikinis will not be allowed. One-piece swimsuits are required for girls. Guys will be required to wear shirts when working at the mission site and sleeping in public places.
- Abstain from the use of alcohol and tobacco while on this trip.
- Work as though working for the Lord, not for men. (Col. 3:23) I will look for ways to help and be a productive team member from start to finish.
- **Commit to be at all of the mission trip meetings**, unless excused in advance by Pastor Sean or Teri. I understand that missing more than one meeting may jeopardize my ability to go on this trip. *NOTE: If you have a concern or questions about this, please talk to Teri or Pastor Sean before you register.*
- **Students must be actively involved in our High School ministry, including a Wednesday night Grounded group.** *An exception may be made for a student who does not attend Christ Church and is actively and regularly involved in their church's youth group on Wednesday nights.*
